

PERIOD POVERTY



When period poverty has become a coined and well-established term, we need to realize that we have a problem. Period poverty describes the struggle many low-income women and girls face while trying to afford menstrual products. The term refers to the increased economic vulnerability people face due the financial burden posed by menstrual supplies. These include not only sanitary towels and tampons, but also related costs such as pain medication and underwear. (Nobel Peace Center 2020)

AT MOTHERWELL, OUR VISION IS THAT WOMEN AND GIRLS ARE ABLE TO MEET THE CHALLENGES IN THEIR LIVES AND ACCESS SUPPORT, EDUCATION, AND ADVOCACY WHENEVER THEY NEED IT, IN ORDER TO FULFIL THEIR POTENTIAL. THE HUB STARTED IN 2019 AS CREWE AND NANTWICH UNIFORM EXCHANGE, FOR THE LOCAL COMMUNITY, A SUSTAINABLE SERVICE THAT GAVE THE LOCAL COMMUNITY A PLACE TO DONATE THEIR NO LONGER NEEDED SCHOOL IN RETURN THEY COULD COLLECT ITEMS THEY REQUIRE. IN OCTOBER 2020 WE LAUNCHED AS THE COMMUNITY SHARE HUB AND THE SERVICE HAS CONTINUED TO EXPAND.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

WE STOCK BOTH PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL UNIFORMS FOR ALL GENDERS, BRANDED ITEMS, AND GENERIC ITEMS.

ITEMS HAVE BEEN DONATED BY THE LOCAL COMMUNITY, MANY LIKE NEW.

Believe - supporting mums and mums to be whose child/ children are on a child protection plan. Each mum has a dedicated support worker who offers bespoke mental health support, and a Mentor to assist with life skills, inspiring more confidence and self belief.



Mums Uniting Mums - empowering women to support themselves and other women on the mothering journey. Support includes: counselling; wellbeing programmes; New Life and Me group for mums of children up to 2 years; Mindful Mums for work life balance.



Inspire - Supporting girls aged 14-18 with their mental health. Includes counselling, peer support, mentoring, therapeutic groups and #IAM Youth Board. Inspire aims to help girls feel more positive about themselves, have improved relationships and feel more able to cope.



Community Share Hub - helping families facing financial difficulties access appropriate school uniform so they don't feel singled out. The Hub provides access to preloved school uniform, school bags, winter coats and even fancy dress.



Bright Stars - our intergenerational mentoring programme for the over 45s. Volunteering opportunities for more mature ladies to share their life experience and nurturing by supporting younger generations of mums who need a helping hand or listening ear.




#IAM Youth Board - girls and young women encouraging, inspiring and empowering other girls. Our board is made up of volunteers aged 14-19. They are shaping campaigns, creating merchandise and creating our Inspire Magazine. The project aims to help other young people with their mental wellbeing.
